SHORT EASTER MESSAGE

About 2015 years ago in the town of Bethlehem in the land of Israel was born a child who was utterly unique. At the age of thirty he began teaching his message and almost immediately ran into trouble: the brick wall he hit was the Church leadership. In those days the Church had a list of over 600 laws that were meant to be kept in order for anyone to enter into heaven. Jesus basically blew their teaching out of the water by saying you can't possibly keep these laws but I have another way of you entering into heaven and it's on the basis of pure gift. It was all too much for the Church leadership and ultimately that's why we have the Easter story.

The Easter story was the attempt at silencing this man and his message for ever. On Good Friday many thought that the problem that was Jesus of Nazareth would be gone once and for all. And for a while it seemed to be the way things were going until some women went to his tomb early on the Sunday morning. They got a massive shock: a shock that has been reverberating around the world ever since. 'He is not here,' they were told, 'He has risen.' And that was it in a nutshell. He came and died in the stead of his people, so that

they might enter heaven, in the world after this one, on the basis of pure gift.
